### Who can enter?

Any student 12 - 18 years old.

### How many videos can each student submit?

Each student may submit one video.

### What kind of videos should you take?

The videos should reflect the student's perspective of "The Rule of Law: Foundation for Communities of Opportunity and Equity"

### What are the selection criteria?

1. Effectiveness in expressing the theme.
2. Quality of the video's design including its composition, use of ambient light, and focusing.
3. Originality in characterizing the theme, "Rule of Law: Foundation for Communities of Opportunity and Equity"
4. Creativity in executing the image.

### What is the deadline?

4:00 pm March 31, 2008.

### Awards

Two \$50 & two \$25 prizes will be awarded, for the best videos taken by students ages 12-14, and for the best videos taken by students ages 15-18. Winners will be honored at the Law Day Ceremony at the Onondaga County Courthouse on **Monday, May 5, 2008 at 9:00 a.m.**

### Rules

1. Videos may be submitted on a DVD or VHS Tape.
2. Videos must be taken by the person entering the contest.
3. Video must have been taken after May 1, 2007.
4. Each video must have a completed contest entry form affixed to the back, as well as a clearly written or typed video title and description of what is represented.
5. Videos must be three minutes long or less.
6. Each participant is solely responsible for obtaining from all applicable individuals or entities any and all required rights, releases, consents, clearances, licenses, and other authorizations necessary to exploit and otherwise use their submitted video in all media.
7. Submitted videos will not be accepted if they contain profane or obscene language; endorse illegal drug use, alcohol abuse, or other illegal activity; contain nudity or extreme gratuitous violence; depictions of any conduct, language or other context deemed inappropriate by the Law Week Committee or judges
